

Sargachi Ramakrishna Mission High School (The first school of Ramakrishna Mission, ESTD. IN 1900 A.D.)

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Admission Notice for Students from Class V to IX for the 2025 Academic Year Through Entrance Examination

Glimpses of the school's Past and Present

It was the month of May, 1897. Swami Akhandananda, one of the renowned disciples of Sri Ramakrishna and very dear to Swami Vivekananda, set out on a journey for the famous places of Bengal towards north along the bank of the Ganges. After crossing Plassey, he reached Dadpur (erstwhile 'Daudpur') village, the faminestricken faces of which moved him deeply. There he came across a lean Muslim girl weeping piteously for breaking her water pitcher. Being perturbed, Akhandanandji bought her a pitcher and a little 'muri'. Seeing it some other starving boys and girls rushed to him. Akhandanandji spent for them the remaining two annas that he had with him and turned literally penniless. The next day before stepping a foot ahead he perceived the divine words of Thakur Ramakrishna in his heart: 'Where are you going? You have lots of work here.' And then the seed of the plant of "Serving man as God" was sown. Famine had to be fought. Akhandanandji worked day and night. Taking a few boys turned orphans due to the famine, he set up an orphanage at an abandoned hut of 'Chandimandap' in the nearby village of Mahula. After a year, the orphanage was shifted to the 'Kachhari bari' in the village of Shibnagar. About fourteen years later, he established an 'Ashrama' at a land of fifty bighas in the village of Sargachi, purchasing it at a cheap rate from a Muslim zamindar and the

orphanage was moved there. The Ashrama continued to expand after his passing away and it presently occupies a hundred bighas of land. Following the instruction of Swami Vivekananda, a Lower Primary School had already been founded in 1900 at Shibnagar by Akhandanandji and it started receiving government grant from the next year. Walking through ups and downs in its long journey of over hundred years that small institution has turned into Sargachi Ramakrishna Mission High School (H.S.) which along with the three units of Primary School is recognised worldwide as the first school of Ramakrishna Mission. Surrounded by ineffable greenery of the Ashrama, the environment of the school is unique in catering to the mental growth of the children.

The primary target of the school is not only to shine academically, but also, to ensure all-round development of the students. Partly residential this school runs at present from class five to class twelve. In spite of many students belonging to first generation learners, the school's result is satisfactory enough every year. Due attention is given to sharpen their sporting skill and to make them interested in cultural and science related activities. Their success every year in these fields is a matter of glory to us.

Ramakrishna Mission always aims at nurturing perfection in human beings. Let us have a look at the emblem of Ramakrishna Mission and the explanation given by Swami Vivekananda.

"The wavy waters in the picture are symbolic of Karma, the lotus of Bhakti, and the rising sun of Jnana. The encircling serpent is indicative of Yoga and awakened Kundalini Shakti, while the swan in the picture stands for Paramatman. Therefore, the ideal of the picture is that by the union of Karma, Jnana, Bhakti and Yoga, the vision of the Paramatman is obtained." It is written in Sanskrit: ' तन्नो हंस: प्रचोदयात् (*Tanno hamsah prachodayat*). ' It means, " May the Supreme Self (the Paramatman) symbolized by the Swan



Approved by WBBSE and WBCHSE, it is a Bengali medium school only for the boys- irrespective of caste, religion and faith. The school maintains a diary named 'Amar Vidyalaya Diary' for building up proper communication among the students, guardians and teachers.

School Uniform:

White shirt and navy-blue pant with white socks and black school shoes. Navy blue sweater, muffler and cap are to be used in winter. Sports dress is compulsory for sporting activities.

School Activities:

(1) Curricular Activities:

The curricular activities of the school start at 10:35 a.m. with the chanting of the holy Vedic hymn through a Prayer Assembly:

" Aum Sahana babatu Sahanau Bhunaktu Saha- viryam Kara-vaa-va-hai Tejas-vinaa-vadhita-mastu Maa Vidvishaa-va hai Aum Shanti, Shanti, Shanti." *(Taittiriya Upanishad)*

Let us be saved together, and be united and strengthened together too. May Brahman protect us both, the preceptor and the disciple. May he nourish us both. May we work together with great energy. May our study be vigorous and fruitful. Let us not be jealous of each other.

For imparting ethical lesson to the students there is a special subject called "Indian Culture and Moral Education" for every class.

For imparting vocational education, the students are allowed to opt for plumbing and automobiles from class nine to class twelve.

The school has a well-equipped library and reading room for the students. For promoting self-study and habit of use of the library, there is an arrangement of regular library class.

There are six well-equipped laboratories of Physics (including a Dark Room), Chemistry, Biology, Computer, Geography and STEM.

Summative tests and class tests are conducted and at the same time special attention is given to the students' formative evaluation.

(2) Co-curricular activities:

There is regular class of yoga, recitation and music. NCC classes (9 Bengal battalion, Murshidabad) are held on regular basis. Special attention is given for developing skills in athletics, cricket and football in addition to the regular physical education classes. We have Science Club, English Club, Heritage Club, Consumer Club and Philately Club for the enrichment of the students. 'Swami Akhandananda Science Cultivation Centre' of the school is in continuous service to arouse interest of the students in science. Cultural department of the school holds various cultural competitions and functions annually.

Others: The museum named 'Truth Beyond Maya' and the Auditorium named 'Vivekananda Savagriha' are unique treasures of the Ashrama enshrining the school

Swami Akhandananda worked untiringly for forty years for the Ashrama enshrining the school. His epochmaking works and words continue to inspire us in the mission of disseminating the message of Sri Ramakrishna: SERVICE TO MAN IS SERVICE TO GOD.

7. For Admission to Class Five and Six: The student must take an entrance examination based on the West Bengal Government's approved curriculum for the previous class, which will include Bengali (30 marks), English (30 marks), Mathematics (40 marks) and Ramakrishna Mission-related topics (10 marks) (for a total of 110 marks). The entrance examination will last 2 hours 20 minutes.

8. <u>Preparation for the Entrance Examination</u>: No coaching classes are organized by the school for preparation for the entrance examination. Previous year's question papers are not provided with the application form.

For preparation, it is recommended to use the government-provided textbooks for Bengali and English, and in addition to the government-provided textbooks for Mathematics, various competitive books may be used.

The supplementary book for "Ramakrishna Mission" related topics is "Srimat Swami Akhandananda"; Publisher: "Ramakrishna Mission Mission Ashrama, Sargachi. The book is available at the school office at the cost of Rs. 40. <u>For</u> <u>Admission to the Hostel for Class Five:</u> Students applying for hostel admission will be considered eligible to stay at the school hostel (Vidyarthi Bhavan) based on the merit list. Interested guardians must fill out a separate form for hostel admission with a fee of Rs. 100. (Seats are limited.)
